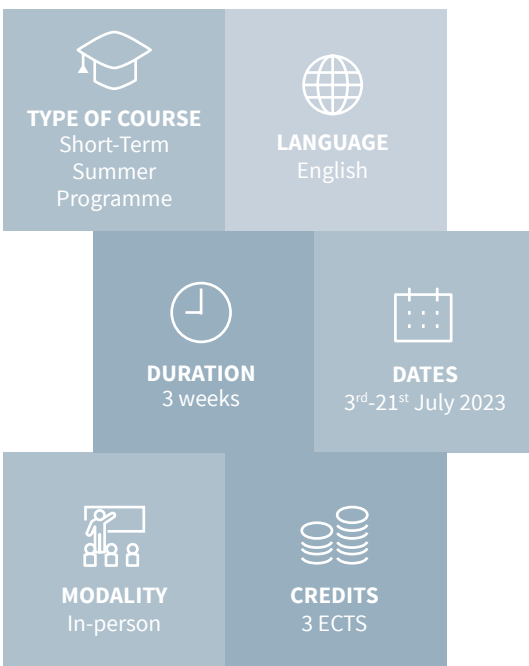

# UCJC Summer School

- **Location:** UCJC Almagro Campus
- **Modality:** In-person
- **Duration:** 3 weeks



UCJC's Summer School is a life-changing 3-week programme designed for undergraduate students and recent graduates who want to have a radically different academic and personal experience in Madrid.

Through an enriching academic curriculum and fun, engaging extracurricular activities, the programme offers a transformative educational experience. It is an excellent opportunity for students to experience life in Madrid, while earning ECTS credits.

**Who:** University students from any academic background and recent graduates.

**When:** 3<sup>rd</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> July 2023.

**Fees:** Full 3-week programme: €2,200.

• **Criminology & Criminal Justice**

On the Criminology & Criminal Justice course, students learn to identify criminal evidence from crime scenes, produce quality reports, understand basic psychiatric concepts related to violent behaviour, discuss criminal justice and propose improvements in public policy. UCJC has a major crime lab that has been renovated and equipped with cutting-edge materials, and its faculty is composed of highly-trained professionals in the field. This course is ideal for anyone who wants to understand the most violent and serious criminal behaviour: homicide. Study in the capital of Spain and take part in the multidisciplinary sciences of criminalistics, criminal law and forensic psychiatry.

• **Digital Media & Communications**

On this course, students gain a 360-degree perspective of new media and global communications in Spain and Europe, not only through real case studies, but also through visits to leading companies in the audio-visual industry. Students gain real experience with top people in the industry and extend their network among likeminded aspiring professionals. Madrid is the third largest city in Europe and the main producer in world news and entertainment content in Spanish. This course is for international students or professionals interested in gaining a broader knowledge of the audio-visual sector.

• **Filmmaking & Spanish Cinema**

The Filmmaking & Spanish Cinema course is designed for students considering a career in filmmaking. This course offers an in-depth view of the fundamental creative processes involved in film and television to candidates with previous basic knowledge of audio-visual production. Students learn about writing, producing and directing in the context of the European film industry, and each produce a short film of their own.

• **Nutrition, Sports & Performance**

On this course, students gain comprehensive knowledge of how nutritional strategies can improve physical performance. They obtain skills to assess the nutritional status of an athlete, analyse energy balance and body composition, understand the main nutritional supplements and ergogenic aids, discuss nutritional strategies associated with weight loss and control, and develop nutritional strategies according to the type of sport.

• **Entrepreneurship & Technology in Business**

On this course, students expand their global business vision as well as technology management skills. They also obtain the hard and soft skills necessary to generate creative and sustainable business solutions based on rigorous diagnoses. It offers a fresh point of view on the current state of international business and entrepreneurship, with a special focus set on the role of tech solutions.

• **Digital Arts, Design & Technology in the City of Madrid**

This course allows students to expand their global skills in digital arts, design and technology. Digital arts has become an essential field of expertise for many sectors and in general economic and social development. Creative industries are one of the main sectors of growth with a high demand for digital services over all possible channels (web, apps, digital TV, streaming platforms, videogames, design, etc.). There is growing interest in professional profiles that mix arts and humanities with technological and digital abilities.

\*If the track does not reach the required minimum number of students, it will not be offered.

**Extracurricular activities** include cultural visits and activities such as a visit to the Prado Museum, a flamenco show, a day trip to Segovia, etc.
